- 4 (a) Defined Term.—In this Act, the term

- 7 (b) Establishment.—The Secretary is authorized
- 8 to enter into a public-private partnership for the purposes
- 9 of establishing a US-ASEAN Center in the United States

4	sion of law, the US-ASEAN Center established pursuant
5	to subsection (b) may—

10	ASEAN trade and investment;
